

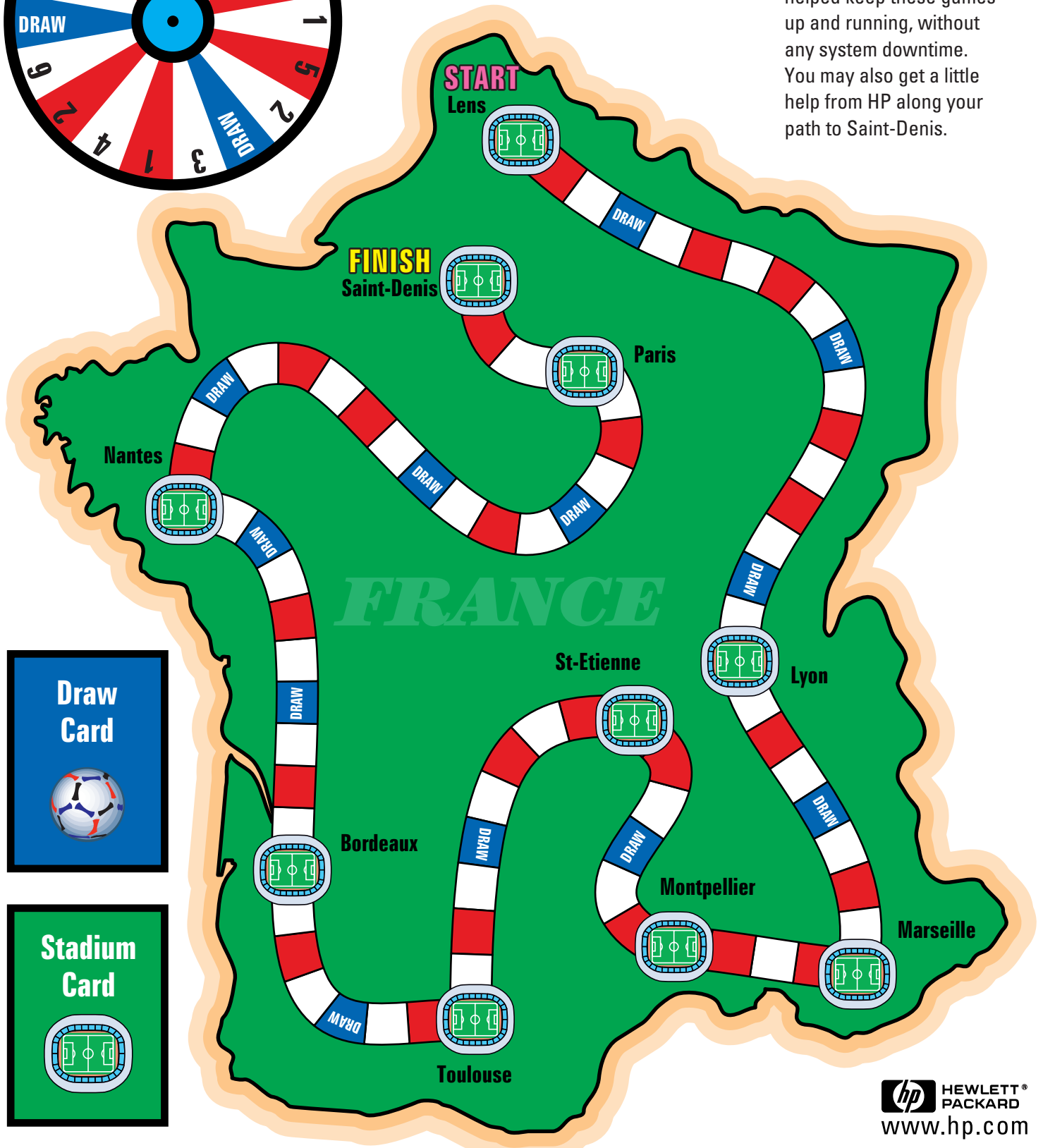


World Cup '98

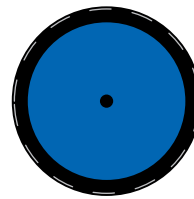


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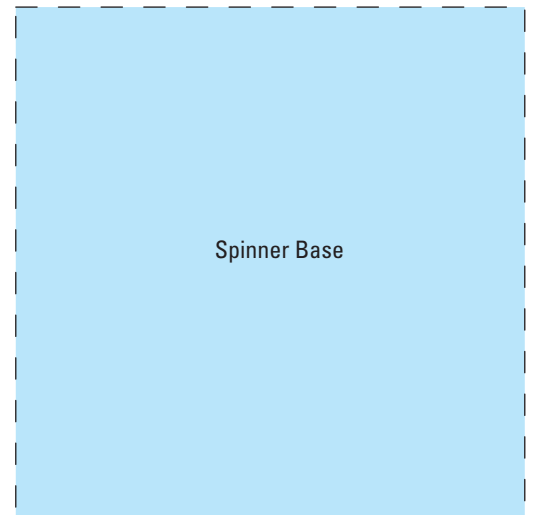

How to Play

To determine order of play, each player flicks the arrow on the spinner until it stops on a number (reflick if it rests on "Draw"). The player with the highest number goes first, second highest goes second etc. Players place their car token at the start in Lens and take turns with the spinner. The car advances the number of squares indicated by the arrow (a stadium counts as a square). If the arrow stops on "Draw", or if the car lands on a "Draw" square, the player takes a "Draw Card" and follows the instructions (if you're instructed to go backward beyond the start, remain at the start). If the car lands on a stadium other than Lens or Saint-Denis, the player takes a "Stadium Card". The first player to reach Saint-Denis wins.



Arrow Washer



Assembly Instructions

Print these pages on the heaviest paper your printer can handle.

Spinner

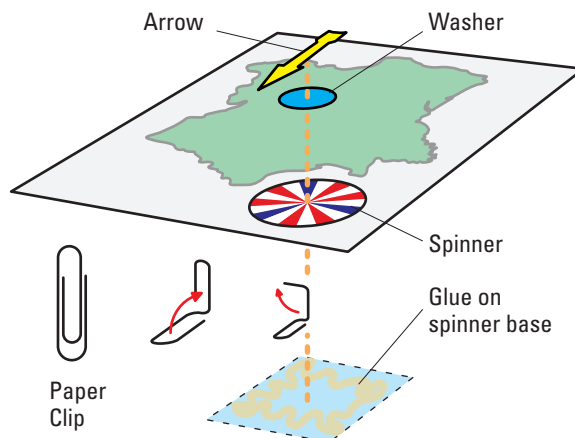
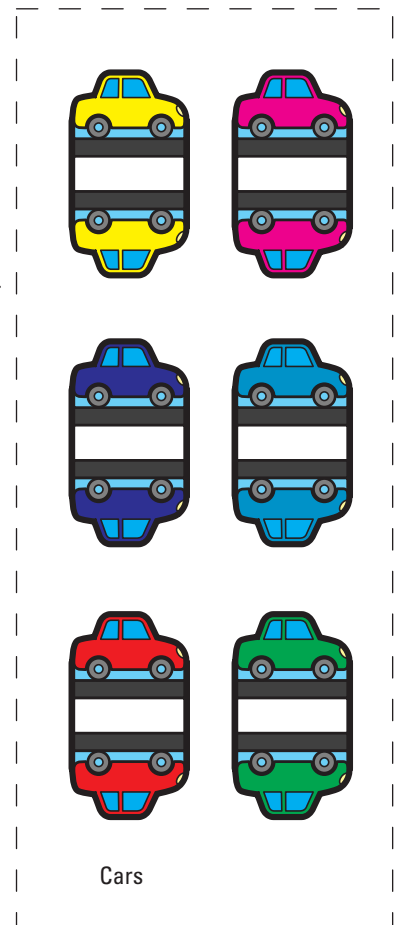


Figure 1. Spinner Installation

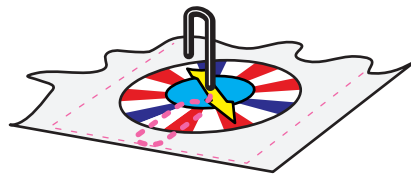


Figure 2. Proper installation of Paper Clip

Carefully cut out the arrow along the outside edge. Fold the arrow on the inner dotted line and glue the two halves together. Carefully cut out the Arrow Washer and Spinner Base. Push a straightened paper clip (or something sharper) through the numbered Spinner Wheel on the board and the cutout Washer and Arrow. Enlarge the hole slightly with the paper clip so the Arrow rotates freely. Bend the end back (as shown in Figure 2). The other end of the paper clip should be perpendicular to the Arrow shaft and glues to the Spinner Base. (Refer to Figure 1)

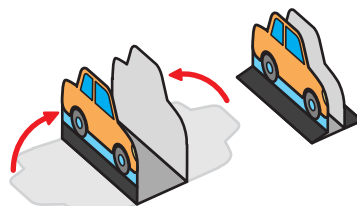
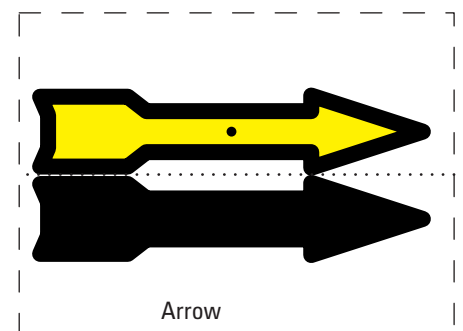




















Figure 3. Car Assembly

Cut out individual cars carefully along outside edges. Fold so that white area is the base and fold again so that dark gray area is the road. Glue the two halves of the car together. (Refer to Figure 3.)

Draw and Stadium Cards

Fold the card pages in half so the instructions back up the front side of the card. Glue the halves together and cut along dotted lines to make individual cards.
